

Woodhorn Education packages on offer:

- KS1 Working Down the Pit – Pupils explore what it was like to be a miner through role play, movement and object handling. Pupils receive a fully fledged miner certificate.
- KS1 A Canny Day Out – Help organise a miner’s picnic, make a banner and join a procession.
- KS1 Home Life – Explore the life of a miner’s wife in 1936. Make a proggy mat and learn to dance the waltz.
- KS2 Danger, Danger – Examine the evidence relating to the Woodhorn Disaster and re-enact the Inquest.
- KS2 The Enemy Within – Through role play pupils will explore the causes and consequences of the 1984 Miner’s Strike.
- KS2 Supermam – Examine the status of women in 1936 and 1984 through object handling and role play. Produce a cartoon or comic strip showing how women are represented.
- KS3 Behind the scenes at the archives – Learn about the enemies to the archive, how to analyse historical sources and hunt for clues to the past.
- KS3 Changing Places - Explore how a town develops using a selection of maps, trade directories and employment details.

A half day session runs between 10-12 or 12.30-2.30 and consists of one led package and a self led tour of the museum. This costs £3 per child.

A full day session runs between 10-2.30 and consists of a led workshop (one from the list of packages available) a guided tour of colliery buildings and a self led tour of the museum. This costs £5 per child.
